Return Plan

Our Kindergarten and Year 1 students have returned very positively and safely this week. We look forward to supporting the full return of our students next Monday with all students required to be learning on site from Monday 25 October. In supporting our return plan we have many safety measures in place:

- Staff are all fully vaccinated
- Staff are wearing masks
- Cohort separation (K-2, 3-4, & 5-6) is in place
- Adequate ventilation is in all learning spaces
- Regular hand washing and sanitizing for everyone
- Extra surface cleaning
- Modified canteen operations to minimise mingling of cohorts
- Arrival and Departure gates processes in place
- No additional people onsite
- Optional mask wearing for students

These measures align with the guidelines from NSW Health and the NSW Department of Education and work to ensure everyone on the school site is safe at all times.

Sickbay Change Reminder

Procedural change from the beginning of Term 4.

All students will be triaged outside the office /sickbay by one of the Administration staff who will decide the appropriate treatment. The staff member will be wearing appropriate Personal Protection Equipment (PPE). This may include face shield, face mask, apron & gloves.

- Students with grazes, bruises or other injuries will be assessed and if required will enter the sickbay and remain for approx. 15 minutes. Within this time an assessment will be made to contact the parent/ guardian to collect the student or the student return to class.
- Any student that is presented to the sickbay with COVID-19 symptoms (coughing, sneezing, sore throat, headache)
 - will remain outside the office, in an isolated appropriate supervised space
 - will be provided with & strongly recommended to wear a mask.
 - parent / guardian is contacted to collect the student as soon as possible

Any student with any COVID-19 symptoms is not able to return to school until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free in alignment with the NSW Health Guidelines.
