Have a great week at our school.

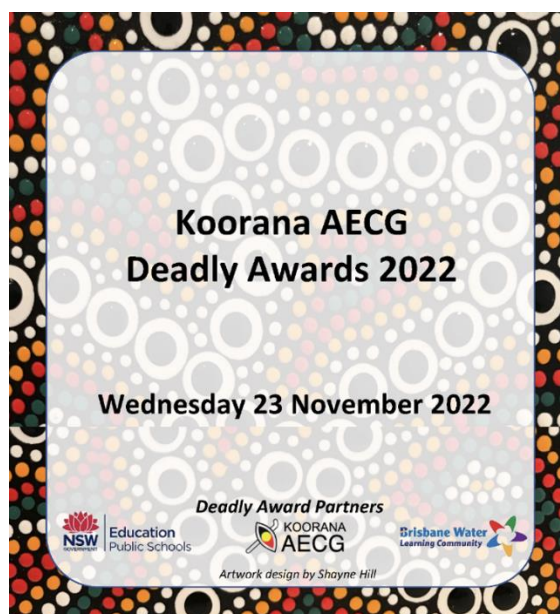

## Stay home if sick!

### COVID-19 symptoms can include:



fever



sore throat



cough



shortness of breath.

If your child is sick, keep them at home and get them tested for COVID-19.

NSW Health has advised schools that incidents of COVID-19 are rising across communities. In consultation with NSW Health, our school is supporting our families and our community by distributing Rapid Antigen Testing Kits. If you did not receive any last week, or would like us to send home some more kits, please contact the school office. We ask that parents use RAT kits at any early signs of illness or following possible exposure to COVID-19, to help identify the infection early and contribute to ongoing school safety. Please be aware that students, staff and visitors should only attend school, or school events, when they are symptom free. We are required to send home students or staff displaying symptoms.

The school will inform the community of any covid-19 cases via the Skoolbag Ap. If you don't have the Ap, please contact the office for support and assistance. If you may have been exposed to COVID-19, it is strongly recommended that you monitor for symptoms and test immediately, should symptoms appear. RAT testing may

help identify the infection early and is important if you are in contact with people at greater risk of serious illness if exposed to COVID-19. Mask wearing is encouraged, and masks are available at school for students, staff and visitors, should you wish to wear a mask.

**If your child contracts COVID-19, please let the school know so that we can inform our community. Your child should only return to school when they are completely symptom-free. Thanks for working with us to keep our community safe.**

End of year events, including school formals, graduations and presentation ceremonies, can proceed within COVID-19 guidelines in place. Wherever possible, the school will hold these events outside. Indoor events will have layered COVID-smart measures as per department guidelines.

Please remember the 'big 5' to help keep our school and community safe:

- Stay home if unwell or showing even the mildest of symptoms.
- Keep up to date with vaccinations – including COVID-19 booster shots and flu vaccines, available from your local GP, pharmacy or Aboriginal Medical Service.
- Get tested immediately for COVID-19 if you become symptomatic.
- Practice good hand hygiene by washing regularly with soap and warm water.
- Take a RAT before visiting vulnerable loved ones or going to large gatherings and events.
