This year at Umina Beach we are introducing a new behaviour support system for our students. This is a levelled system that aims give students targeted support and strategies to make positive choices at school. This is a whole school system from Kindergarten to Year 6.

To support students make positive choices we will be using the S.T.O.P process. S.T.O.P stands for


Short Time Out Process.

What is a short time-out?

- A **Short time-out** is where your teacher might move you away from distractions for a short time.
- Usually, students need only a few minutes to re-set and "get back in the zone"
- A **Short time-out** gives you a chance to reflect on how you are thinking and feeling.


Why do teachers use STOP?

- All our teachers use the same language to remind students if their behaviour is stopping their learning (or the learning of others).
- All our teachers will offer **help** and **support** to help students get back on track.
- All our teachers will give reminders to let students know that they might need a short timeout if they are not in the **zone for learning.**





Students who display Orange behaviours **or** have 3 yellow behaviours in 10 days will attend Sort and Talk. Students who display Red behaviours will also attend Sort and Talk.
